

## 8. Boyd Epley Consulting and Family Time

My good friend Craig Christenson and I enjoyed watching Terrance Crawford win a boxing match in Omaha. The TV caught a glimpse of my beard in he second row.






2020 - Jenna celebrated her 10<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary with Chase Beideck.
